Camp New Friends serves to reduce the isolation often associated with neurological disorders and chronic health conditions. Parents can feel confident that their children are under the care of a pediatric team specializing in their child's condition. Counselors are trained in dealing with the issues associated with neuromuscular disease. We also invite counselors and volunteers who live with the condition themselves to share their experiences with the campers.
